

AYHE PRODUCTIONS - DAVID AYMERICH

Ahye Productions is a production company founded by producer David Aymerich. The company's goal is to produce quality feature and short films. Stories of new voices of our cinema, with great audience appeal and internationalization potential.

Ahye Productions began its journey producing the debut feature "El dulce sabor del limón" (David Aymerich, 2018) and the documentary "3.450km" (David Aymerich, 2019), productions acquired by, among others, Movistar+.

Recently, Ayhe has produced "SOLO" (Alberto Gross Molo, 2022). The work has been nominated for Best Short Film at the Gaudí Awards 2023 after its passage through prestigious festivals such as Bogoshorts, In The Palace, FESCIGU or Cortogenia, where "SOLO" also won the award for Best Direction, Production and Leading Actor.

Currently, the production company is developing Alberto Gross Molo's opera prima: "Catorce de marzo". The work has participated in European workshops supported by Creative Europe Media such as Ekran+ and My First Script, as well as the Faberllull Lab and, currently, La Incubadora ECAM. The script of "Catorce de marzo" has been a finalist in the XIX SGAE Screenplay Awards Julio Alejandro 2022.

Ahye is also working on the development of the fiction feature film "Younger Days", written and directed by Gerard Vidal Barrena -Biznaga de Plata at the Malaga Festival 2020 for Best Director for "Les dues nits d'ahir" (2020)-, participating in the RIFF Work In Progress 2022 (Reykjavik, Iceland) with the support of Creative Europe Media, and recently at the D'A Film Lab in Barcelona, where he won the Music library & vfx Award for the development of the project.
